CARING FOR KIDS

Every Child offers many ways for community members to love, care for, and support vulnerable children and their families.

Together, we are transforming Lane County through radical and unprecedented support for this crisis. EVERY CHILD NEEDS YOU!



(several hours - several days)

Be on the Every Child List of Volunteers and we will send you opportunities to connect with and care for children in foster care. OR you can also be on the DHS respite list to be connected to families!



(forever family!)

It is our heart that all children are reunited with their families when able and safe to do so. It is also our heart that EVERY CHILD has a place to call home.

Short-Term Shelter Care

(several hours - up to 20 days)

Caring for children in foster care temporarily when a long-term placement is unavailable or the DHS office is closed.

Long-Term Foster Care

(several days - 2 years)

Providing a home for a child in foster care until they can be reunified with a birth parent, family member, or adopted.

Children had multiple placements under DHS protection

Reports of abuse or neglect that required a DHS investigation. Without support, these families may require future DHS intervention.
